


Remote Paid Internships are designed for alumni to support next generation while building skills and managing YG specific projects

YG District Details



District

- Regional YMCA host the fall conference
- Host YMCA follows program rules and standards set by the state office
- Districts smaller than 75 students, receive permission from state office to offer regional conference or attendance to neighboring district
- All volunteers and advisors must complete annual background check and child abuse prevention certificate


Participation

- Clubs must be active and registered with the regional YMCA to participate
- Clubs are welcome to enroll as many students as they choose. We have no regional limits.
- Students participating in regional conferences must complete and pay state program registration and district conference registration
- Parental signatures are required for all program participants

Road to State

- Each district will be allotted a percentage of state conference spots bases on overall percent of participations in region
- Program registration and district conference participation are required for state selection
- Clubs must meet adult to student ratios for registration 1-10
- State Conference is held annually in Austin, Texas
- State Office is the host for state conferences
