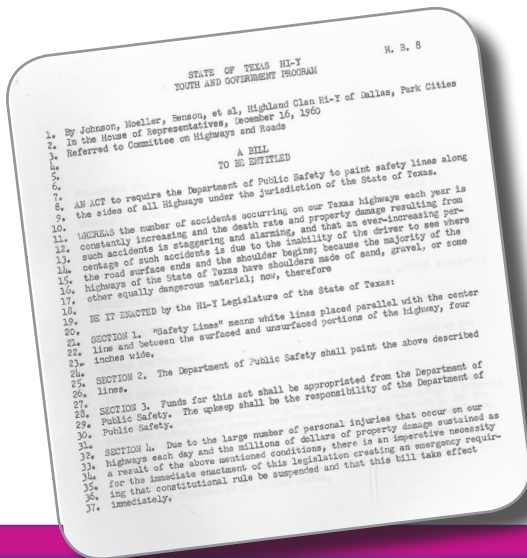

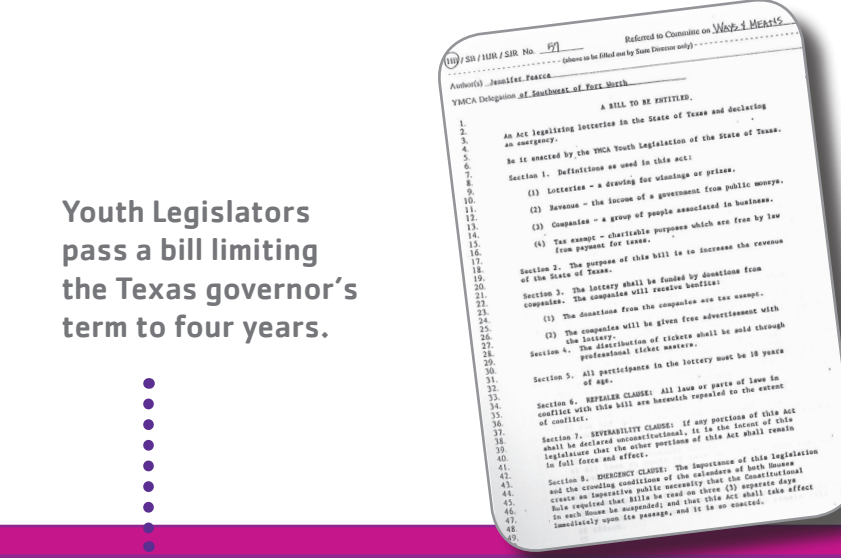
YMCA Texas Youth & Government legislation over the years

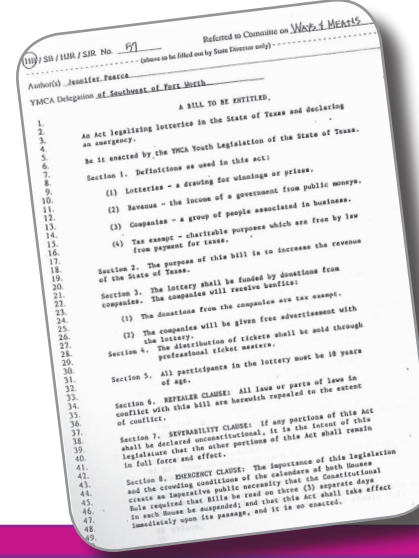
1960
